What is involved in my Solar Installation – In depth

From the customer's point of view the quote contains the following aspects:

To receive a quote:

Our solar Photovoltaic (PV) supplier will contact you to arrange a time to complete a site inspection of your property.

The site inspection is used to determine the purpose of the installation and to help you select the right system for you, from a standard PV system to different sizes and variations, other contributing factors such as your energy use, and current tariff situation will also be a contributing factor to what type of system are best for you.

A property inspection will also include an inspection of your roof ie: what material it is constructed with, , the size of your roof, orientation, (is it facing north), to the tilt and strength of your roof. Whilst inspecting your roof the installer will also see what kind of PV mounting issues there will be, and how much shading is on the roof from trees etc.

The installer will also investigate the location of the main switch board (MSB) and the potential route and quality of cables needed from the MSB to the roof and consider potential sites for the inverters to be located on your property.

The installer will provide a written quote after the inspection. This will include:

- A step by step explanation about what will happen from here;
- All the information about the products we suggest;
- Details about all the warranties and guarantees; and
- Details about who to contact to explain any part of your quote or the next step.
